
church for many years, they found that they had different ideas of what constitutes the "perfect pastor."







San Antonio Police Misapply City Ordinance to Silence Street Preacher

(EP News)--Sharing the Gospel in public is now a dicey proposition in San Antonio, Tex.

Street preacher Jose Muniz, a full-time minister with Jesus Crew Street ministries, was on multiple occasions harassed and threatened by San Antonio police for handing out Bible tracts and sharing his faith.

Liberty Institute and the American Center for Law and Justice (ACLJ, the Christian legal firms that filed a federal lawsuit on Muniz's behalf, said the officers consistently misapplied a city ordinance intended to prevent the distribution of commercial handbills.

In fact, the ordinance clearly sets the boundaries:"This section is not intended to prevent the lawful distribution of anything other than commercial and business advertising." ACLJ attorney Wesley Southerland said that Muniz was not the only one harassed for sharing his faith. Another evangelist, Todd Liebovitz, was thrown in jail for 16 hours before the charges were dropped. Both men were accused of illegally handing out literature under various city ordinances.

"It seem like they're being applied specifically in these cases because of possibly their religious viewpoint," Southerland said, "and the fact that they are Christians and they want to share their message."

"This is America. No citizen should be threatened for engaging in free speech in public," said Kelly Shackelford, Liberty Institute's president and CEO. "This was a flagrant violation of the Constitution."

able interpositions of His providence in the course and conclusion of the late war."

Thomas Jefferson (author of the Declaration of Independence and America's 3rd President) said, "God who gave us life gave us liberty," and, "Can the liberties of a nation be thought secure when we have removed their only firm basis, a conviction in the minds of the people that these liberties are of the Gift of God? That they are not to be violated but with His wrath?" He also said, "I tremble for my country when I reflect that God is just: that His justice cannot sleep forever."

Virtually everyone at the time of America's founding attributed divine blessing and protection to the establishment of these States United. That fact is undeniable--at least by any honest and objective student of history.

Indeed, Jefferson's warning is as germane today (perhaps even more so) as it was when he wrote it: "Can the liberties of a nation be thought secure when we have removed their only firm basis, a conviction in the minds of the

people that these liberties are of the Gift of God? That they are not to be violated but with His wrath?" Meaning: The God who gave and protected our liberties is the same God who can remove and overthrow them in His wrath and judgment. Some would even argue that this is what God is currently doing: removing His hand of protection from America and turning us over to divine judgment. he was) when he said, "God grants liberty only to those who love it and are always ready to guard and defend it," then liberty's future is suspect indeed. There is another

> principle, however, that is equally true: there will always remain a remnant of people who value freedom enough to never surrender it.

During the past two years, I have traveled over 60,000 miles to virtually every crack and corner of this country, and I can tell you without hesitation or equivocation: not every place (or State) understands--or is prepared to fight to defend--freedom. All men may be created equal, but all men are not equally discerning or determined. If I observed anything, I observed the great disparity between people when it comes to their willingness to draw a line in the sand for liberty--especially when that line is being drawn against their own federal government. Oh, there may exist pockets of such people scattered here and there in certain geographical regions, but I'm talking about a concentration of determined citizenry armed and alert to the usurpations of their liberties. There are only a few places where I observed such a spirit. And if you have read my last 3 columns, you know that I have been led to the studied conclusion that the Mountain States region of America's great Northwest is certainly one of those places, if not the most notable of those places.

Granted, there is a sizeable freedom spirit in many local communities around the country. I have especially found the freedom spirit scattered throughout Texas, Arizona, South Carolina, Missouri, Oklahoma, Vermont, Kentucky, New Hampshire, and eastern Tennessee (and several other places),

but not in the concentrated aggregation as in states such as Idaho, Montana, Wyoming, Alaska, Utah, South Dakota (maybe even North Dakota), and eastern Washington

Accordingly, I am absolutely convinced that God is calling a determined remnant of freedomlovers to the Mountain States. the feast, Samhain assembled the spirits of all who had died during the previous year to return to their former home to visit the living.

Human and Animal Sacrifices

On Halloween, for thousands of years, druid priests have conducted diabolical worship ceremonies in which cats, horses, sheep, oxen, human beings and other offerings were rounded up, stuffed into wicca cages and burned to death. These human and animal sacrifices were apparently required to appease Samhain and keep the spirits from harming them.

Trick or Treat

To obtain these sacrifices, druid priests would go from house to house asking for fatted calves, black sheep and human beings. Those who gave were promised prosperity, and those who refused to give were threatened and cursed. This is the origin of "trick or treat."

Jack-O-Lantern

The Jack-O-Lantern has its origin in the candle-lit pumpkin or skull, which served as a signal to mark

those farms and homes that supported the druids' religion, and thus were seeking the "treat" when the terror of Halloween began. The World Book Encyclopedia says: "The apparently harmless lighted pumpkin face of the Jack-O-Lantern is an ancient symbol of a damned soul."

Dance of Death

While people and animals were screaming in agony, being burnt to death, the druids and their followers would dress in costumes made of animal skins and heads. They would dance, chant and jump through the flames in the hope of warding off evil spirits.

House of Horrors

One of the popular heroes of Halloween, Count Dracula, was also a real person. Dracula lived from 1431 to 1476. During his six year reign, Count Dracula massacred over 100,000 men, women and children in the most hideous ways. He devised a plan to rid his country of the burden of beggars, the handicapped, the sick and the aged by inviting them to a feast at one of his palaces. He fed them well and got them drunk. Then he asked them: "Do you want to be without cares, lacking nothing in the world?" When his guests yelled: "Yes!" Dracula ordered the palace boarded up and set on fire. No one escaped this original "house of horror."

The Word of God

"When you come into the land, which the Lord your God is giving you, you shall not learn to follow the abominations of those nations. There shall not be found among you anyone who makes his son or his daughter pass through the fire, or one who practices witchcraft, or a soothsayer, or one who interprets





Remove Religious Hiring Rights Protections

(EP News)--Rep. Patrick Kennedy, D-R.I., recently sponsored a bill that attempts to amend the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) for the first time in 46 years – and remove religious exemptions for faith-based organizations that receive federal funds. According to the bill, it would affect "licensed professional counselors, marriage and family therapists, pastoral counselors, psychosocial rehabilitation specialists, and any other individual determined to be appropriate by the Secretary." Steve McFarland, chief legal officer for World Vision, said this bill has huge implications for religious organizations across the country. Faith-based groups are worried that when Congress returns in mid-September, the Democrats may attempt to, through a simple budget resolution, implement the dangerous language throughout all levels of government.

New Report: Record **Increase in Poverty;** Collapse of Marriage **Primary Cause**

(EP News)--The U.S. Census Bureau released new data on Sept. 16 – one in seven Americans now live in poverty. This is the largest increase in recorded U.S. history. According to the Heritage Foundation, the collapse of marriage is the root cause of the poverty explosion. Its latest report illustrates the direct correlation between the rise in welfare and poverty rates with the collapse of marriage. Children born to single mothers are at least five times more likely to live in poverty than those born into married families. This is devastating news for 51.3 percent of Hispanic children and 71.6 percent of African American children who are born out-of-wedlock. Glenn Stanton, director of Family Formation Studies for Focus on the Family, agreed with the findings. "Research tells us that children are impoverished in every way we know how to measure a child's well-being," Stanton said, "when they do not grow up with their own mother and father."

Glenn Beck Advocates a Renewal of Values in **America**

(EP News) - On Aug. 26, from

the steps of the Lincoln Memorial, conservative broadcaster Glenn Beck told the crowd gathered on the National Mall that their nation has "wandered in darkness" for too long. Estimates varied from 1000,s to 100,000 -500,000 and some said a million, conservative and tea party activists, including former vice presidential candidate Sarah Palin, gathered at the Restoring Honor rally, which called upon America to return to its roots and to God. The rally drew both attention and criticism due to its date – on the anniversary of Dr. Martin Luther King's "I Have A Dream" speech, delivered at the same spot, as well as what some consider to be Beck's commercial and partisan motivations. But Beck mostly ignored the criticism and stuck to his message. "Something beyond imagination is happening," Beck declared. "America today begins to turn back to God." The rally also promoted the Special Operations Warrior Foundation, which provides scholarships and services to family members of military servicemen and women. Some conservative Christians were not in agreement with the Restoring Honor Rally and the tea party activist. Many say that Beck is proclaiming a false Christianity, citing Glenn Beck's Mormon beliefs as being in contradiction with the beliefs of the Christian church.

Massachusetts Abortionist Sentenced to Jail for Abortion Death

(Operation Rescue) Barnstable, MA - Abortionist Rapin Osathanondh, 67, was sentenced to six months in jail today after pleading guilty yesterday to one count of manslaughter in the 2007 abortionrelated death of 22-year old Laura Hope Smith.

Osathanondh will serve three months in a county jail after which he will likely be paroled. He must then serve nine months under home confinement with an electronic monitoring device, and three years of probation. In addition, Osathanondh is barred from practicing medicine and teaching, according to a plea agreement that was reached after a day of in-court

Also settled was the civil suit filed by Smith's mother, Eileen Smith. Osathanondh agreed to pay the family a substantial sum of money as a punitive measure.

"Today, justice was done," said Operation Rescue President Troy Newman, who helped advise Eileen Smith after her daughter's death and encouraged her to file complaints with the medical board and prosecutors. "Our condolences and prayers continue to be with the Smith family, who showed such an amazing strength of faith and courage throughout this ordeal."

Less than 1-in-5 Support Fox News host Glenn Beck as Religious Leader

(EP News)--Following the rally where Fox News television host Glenn Beck called for a religious renewal in America, less than 1in-5 (17 percent) believe Glenn Beck is the right person to lead a religious movement, according to a PRRI/RNS Religion News Poll, conducted by Public Religion Research Institute in partnership with Religion News Service.

The PRRI/RNS Religion News Poll also found that roughly an equal number of Americans have favorable and unfavorable opinions of Beck (28 percent and 27 percent respectively), but nearly 4-in-10 say they haven't heard enough to have an opinion.

"Beck's favorability is highest

among Republicans (55 percent), white evangelical Protestants (48 percent), and Americans 65 and over (37 percent); but even among those with a favorable opinion of him, less than half (45 percent) think he is the right person to lead a religious movement," said Dr. Robert P. Jones, CEO of Public Religion Research Institute.

The survey found that Beck's own religious affiliation -- the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints (the Mormon Church) -- may hamper his ability to lead a religious movement and limit his own appeal. A majority of Americans (57 percent) say they don't know his religious affiliation, with less than 1-in-5 (17 percent) correctly identifying his religion as

Mormon. But among those who can identify it, perceptions of the Mormon faith have a significant impact on attitudes toward Beck. Among those who know Beck is Mormon and believe Mormons have similar religious beliefs to their own, a majority (53 percent) say that he is the right person to lead a religious movement, and fully 79 percent have a favorable opinion of him. However, among those who know Beck is Mormon but believe Mormons have different religious beliefs from their own, less than one-third (28 percent) believe he is the right person to lead a religious movement and significantly fewer (54 percent) have a favorable opinion of him.

Given that relatively few people area aware of his religion, Beck's popularity has not been significantly impacted by public perceptions of the Mormon faith. However, if Beck continues to make his faith a more central part of his public persona, that could change. Nearly two-thirds (64 percent) of Americans perceive Mormon religious beliefs to be different from their own. Among white evangelical Protestants, the religious group with the highest favorability rating for Beck, more than two-thirds say that Mormons have religious beliefs somewhat (26 percent) or very (42 percent) different from their own. And similar proportions of Republicans, another group highly supportive of Beck, also say that Mormons have religious beliefs somewhat (29 percent) or very (40 percent)

different from their own.

"The disparity between Glenn Beck's favorability ratings and how people feel about him as a religious leader suggests that people are more drawn to him for political reasons than religious ones," said Daniel Cox, Director of Research for Public Religion Research Institute. "Many of Beck's strongest supporters, such as Republicans and white Evangelicals, perceive real differences between their own faith and Beck's Mormon faith, and this may become a liability in his efforts to

Congressional petition targets **ObamaCare**

(OneNewsNow) A Republican lawmaker on Capitol Hill has launched an effort for full repeal of President Obama's healthcare

Rep. Steve King (R-Iowa) is working to repeal ObamaCare, but he first must acquire 218 signatures -a majority of the House -- to force a discharge petition and bring a vote before the House of Representatives. While it is difficult to reach the signature requirement, King says the effort has two goals.

"One is to force the repeal, which then has to pass the Senate and survive somehow a presidential veto. And the other component...is that it defines and separates the men from the boys and the women from the girls on who actually opposes ObamaCare and who put up a vote just for political survival."

A discharge petition forces a bill out of committee, typically without the cooperation of leadership. As such, it often is viewed -- if successful -- as embarrassing to that leadership, making members of the majority party hesitant to get onboard with it.

Regardless, King contends his petition supporting repeal of ObamaCare is gaining momentum, with the addition of the 173rd signature. Representative Gene Taylor of Mississippi is the first Democrat to sign the discharge petition. King is hopeful others will break their party ranks and support the repeal.

"Now the other 33 Democrats who voted 'no' on ObamaCare do not have an excuse for not signing on, such as were Democrats [who say] 'we don't sign discharge petitions," he observes. "So I think we will pick up other Democrats; [and] there are still six Republicans who haven't signed yet."

If the discharge petition reaches 218 signatures, Speaker Nancy Pelosi will not be able to prevent the repeal legislation from receiving, and passing, a vote on the

Environmental group says Jordan River unsafe for baptisms

ISRAEL/JORDAN (ANS) -- An environmental group says the Jordan River, where Christians believe Jesus was baptized by John the Baptist, is severely polluted, and is warning against future baptismal ceremonies.

Untreated sewage, agricultural run-off, saline water and fish pond effluent has made the Jordan River unsafe for humans, said Gidon Bromberg of Friends of the Earth Middle East, according to a report by Jenna Lyle for www. christiantoday.com.

The reason, said Bromberg, was due to "ninety-eight per cent of the Jordan's fresh waters being diverted by Israel, Syria, and Jordan."

Lyle reports that Friends of the Earth have called on "regional authorities to halt baptism in the lower Jordan River until water quality standards for tourism activities were met."


The Israeli site, known as Qasar al-Yahud, draws more than two million Christians each year. Thousands of them visit the holy site to be baptized, Lyle reports.

According to Lyle's report, Friends of the Earth argues that high levels of "coliform bacteria" from sewage in the river have made it unsafe for bathing.

But water tests released last week suggest otherwise, Eli Dror of Israel's Nature and Parks Authority told Reuters.

"There's absolutely no problem with the quality of the water.

People can come and baptize here as much as they want, I guarantee it," Dror said. Tourism Minister Stas Misezhnikov said he was pleased that tourists would be able to continue visiting and using the site safely, Lyle also states in her



The website also states that Israel's Tourism Ministry

has invested millions of dollars recently to renovate the site, which is located in a closed military area near the West Bank city of Jericho. It was in this river that two thousand years ago John the Baptist is

said to have baptized Jesus Christ and his followers.

On the Jordan side of the river is the "Baptism Site" which is said to be one of the most important recent discoveries in biblical archaeology. Excavations only began there in 1996, following Jordan's peace treaty with Israel in 1994, but they have already uncovered more than 20 churches, caves and baptismal pools dating from the Roman and Byzantine periods.

Although the identification is not absolutely, certain, archaeology

> has shown that the area known as Wadi Kharrar has long been believed to be the biblical Bethany-beyond-the-Jordan, where John the Baptist lived and Jesus was baptized. This area is also associated with the ascension of the Prophet Elijah into heaven, which is commemorated at a hill called Tell Mar Elias.

Note: This Bethany should not be confused with Bethany in Jerusalem, where Mary Magdalene lived and Lazarus was raised from the dead.

USAID Uses Taxpayer **Funds to Push Abortion in Philippines**

(EP News)--The United States Agency for International Development (USAID) is using taxpayer dollars to market contraceptives and "family planning" services to the Philippines. With the assistance of the Philippine government, USAID will launch a marketing campaign that focuses on "increasing modern contraceptive use through demand generation," and "repackaging or selling the concept of family planning as a lifestyle that contributes to better quality of life." Unfortunately, the predominately Catholic nation does not have laws, regulations or policies limiting the selling of contraceptives or abortion services. Human Life International's Country director for the Philippines, Dr. Rene Bullecer, said, "The US government, through USAID, finds it now very easy to push their anti-life agenda to the Philippines with minimal pressure for the reason that the current Filipino administration under President Aquino is a known ally of President Obama, and a prochoice advocate himself."

Billionaire Soros Donates \$100 Million to Anti-Family, Anti-Faith Group

(EP News)--Billionaire liberal activist George Soros announced on Sept. 7 that he plans to donate \$100 million to Human Rights Watch (HRW) – a "non-partisan, watch dog" organization that purports to alert the United Nations on human rights abuses. HRW, however, is better known for demanding the closure of Guantanamo Bay and civilian trials for its detainees. Soros said his intention was to transform the organization into an international force by expanding its presence in "emerging power centers," including Brazil, Mexico, India and China. Soros has long sought to undermine domestic and foreign policies - everything from marriage and life to U.S. support for Israel – through his active funding of counter-cultural groups including: Catholics in Alliance for the Common Good(pro-abortion), EMILY's List (pro-abortion), National Organization for Women (NOW), Planned Parenthood (pro- abortion), Moveon.org, Democracy Alliance (progressive grassroots organization), Human Rights Campaign (pro-GLBT agenda), Open Society Institute (promotes "sex workers" rights, drug legalization, euthanasia, etc.), Earth Institute ("Green" agenda), the Center for American Progress (Think-tank for Obama Administration), Media Matters, and the Service Employees International Union (SEIU).

Chinese Province Teaches Abstinence Curriculum

Moroccan Convert Serving 15 Years for His Faith

KENITRA, MOROCCO (ANS) -- Compass Direct News (CDN) is reporting that nearly five years into the prison sentence of the only Christian in Morocco serving time for his faith, Moroccan Christians and advocates question the "harsh measures of the Muslim state toward a man who dared speak openly about Jesus."

The CDN story said that by the end of December Jamaa Ait Bakrim, 46, will have been in prison for five years at Morocco's largest prison, Prison Centrale, in Kenitra.

It went on to say that an outspoken Christian convert, Bakrim was sentenced to 15 years prison for

"proselytizing" and destroying "the goods of others" in 2005 after burning two defunct utility poles located in front of his private business in a small town in south Morocco.

Advocates and Moroccan Christians said, however, that the severity of his sentence in relation to his misdemeanor shows that authorities were determined to put him behind bars because he persistently spoke about his faith.

"He became a Christian and didn't keep it to himself," said a Moroccan Christian and host for Al Hayat Television who goes only by his first name, Rachid, for security reasons. "He shared it with people around him."

The CDN story added that authorities in Agadir tried Bakrim for "destruction of the goods of others," which is punishable with up to 20 years in prison, and for proselytism under Article 220, which is punishable with six months to three years in prison.

During his defense at the Agadir court in southern Morocco, Bakrim did not deny his Christian faith and refuted accusations that he had approached his neighbors in an attempt to "undermine their Muslim faith." Though there have been other cases of Christians imprisoned for their faith, none of their sentences has been as long as Bakrim's.

"They will just leave him in the prison so he dies spiritually and psychologically," said Rachid. For more information, please go to: www.compassdirect.org

Ugandan Ethics Minister to Porn Dealers: 'Your Days

(LifeSiteNews.com) KAMPALA - The Ugandan government has announced a new legislative initiative to widen the definition of pornography and to eliminate its distribution from the country.

Dr. James Nsaba Buturo, the nation's Ethics and Integrity Minister, says that the new law will help to eliminate the "terrible vice" of pornography, and help to discourage other vices related to it, such as homosexual behavior. "Pornography leads to homosexuality," said Buturo in a recent press conference. "I'm happy that, finally, a bill to eliminate pornography in Uganda will be ready to punish the promoters of this vice."

Those convicted of distributing

pornographic materials will be of spouses. subject to fines, loss of their business, and anywhere from five to ten years in prison. "Those who deal in pornographic materials, your days are numbered," Buturo said during the press conference. He also stated that "we have finally acted and this time, this law will work because our integrity is not for sale."

According to the Ugandan Monitor, the new bill will define pornography as "any form of communication from literature to fashion or photography that depicts unclothed or under-clothed parts of the human body (such as breasts, thighs, buttocks or genitalia), that narrates or depicts sexual intercourse or that describes or exhibits anything that can lead to erotic stimulation." Exceptions will be given in certain cases, such as sports or the private lives

Buturo said that the legislation had been provoked by "an increase in pornographic materials in the Ugandan mass media and nude dancing in entertainment world," and said that the legislation had already reached the level of discussion in the general cabinet.

UN Treaty Used to Threaten Homeschool Families

PURCELLVILLE, Va This week the fate of four homeschooling families will be decided in Botswana. The families, adherents to the Seventh Day Adventist Church, have been ordered by a judge to send their children to public school.

Despite the judges' findings indicating that the children were cared for and that the parents took steps to provide for the education of their children, they still need to go to public school because Botswana has acceded to the U.N. Convention on the Rights of the Child.

The legal standard under the UNCRC is the "best interests of the child." In other words, the state has the authority to determine how children should be raised and educated.

"HSLDA has warned about the danger of the UNCRC to homeschooling families. It gives almost unlimited powers to judges to decide how children should be raised," said Mike Donnelly, Director of International Relations for HSLDA. "We are asking our 85,000 member families to contact the Botswana Embassy

and Office of the President of Botswana to protect these families' basic rights to decide what is best for their children," he added.

The Botswana families are determined to continue homeschooling. "I must obey God. The schools here are corrupt and teach my children things that go against our faith and our values. I cannot allow them to go to these schools," said Mr. Modimoothata, a retired technician and father of four teenagers. His wife Margaret is a senior project manager for Botswana railways.

"We find the behavior of the Botswana police and courts outrageous and hope that more responsible leadership will be applied to remedy this situation without undue trauma to these children," said Leendert Van Oostrum, Director of The Pestalozzi Trust, a South Africa-based homeschooling legal defense organization that is representing the families.

The only "historic" health care reform dating back 100 years ago is 'The Flexner Report'. I was somewhat surprised that the Flexner Report was known by President Obama -- or at least by whoever writes for him.

Abraham Flexner was commissioned (financed) by Andrew Carnegie and the American Medical Association to assess health care in America. This resulted in 'The Flexner Report' of 1910.

This report advocated that the Germanic system of hospital and drug based medicine should be the focus of American health care, and that government and academia should partner together to accomplish this end -- which is exactly what happened very quickly. The report was a foregone conclusion from its commissioning with deeply entrenched biases.

Abraham Flexner was a university educator -- and also an old crony, or more accurately flunky (or stooge) of John D. Rockefeller, Sr. There were not a whole lot of cars in the marketplace to accommodate the vast reservoirs of Rockefeller's oil in 1910. However, drugs and patent medicines made (and still make) extensive use of that oil.

Flexner was also the son of German immigrants and was well traveled in -- and favorable to -- Europe and its ways. The American Medical Association and Andrew Carnegie (buddy to Rockefeller) were paying for this report so the conclusions would accordingly be favorable to their interests in drug based medical practice. Flexner decried any mode of healing not drug based as without value and fraudulent.

It did not take long for almost anything not medical to be driven from the marketplace with the driving force of government and select academic institutions behind the Flexner report.

Flexner also regaled against all

educational institutions in the state of Tennessee but noted that in the interest of having at least one such institution approved in every state that Vanderbilt University should be given assistance to come up to standards. This resulted in huge financial subsidies being granted to that school. Of course, no mention was made that the chancellor of Vanderbilt was the next door neighbor as well as hunting and fishing buddy of Abraham Flexner.

The conflicts of interest between pharmaceutical interests and government receiving growing attention in recent years is actually the root foundation of modern medical practice in America.

The past decade or so has also seen growing interest in non-medical approaches to health care resulting in slight but growing weakness in the near total monopoly propped up by government of medical practice in America.



The unusual name Glaen is pronounced, glain (rhymes with brain). Another unusual thing about the book is its cover. There is a beverage container labeled "a novel message on: romance, love & relating." Fred Lybrand, the author, has written this book about all three but in novelette form. Just as Jesus spoke in parables, Mr. Lybrand teaches us about Christian romance, love & relating within the novelette. I think his idea works and I'll tell you why – because I learned something.

Glaen is about a professor, named Glaen Breuch, in a Christian college. He is teaching a course called Original Non-Fiction and his only student is a graduate student, Anne Hughes. Anne is struggling through a lot of life issues including being puzzled by romance, love & relating. In the class, she decides to write about relationships between Christian women and men. It is here that we learn about what the author Lybrand is presenting to us.

Anne takes notes:

Theory 1 – Traditional Dating

- 1. getting to know each other
- 2. exclusivity in dating
- 3. intimate physical affection

Theory 2 – Courting

- 1. financial stability
- 2. emotional stability
- 3. spiritual stability

Glaen questions, "what if neither theory works? You have been designed for tension. Tension is why people keep reading books or keep watching a movie – because they are into it far enough that they can't leave off!" Relationships are about tension and resolution. Tension seeks resolution. Fiction works by getting you to wonder what's next, what's next, what's next? Non-Fiction explains how. Tension seeks resolution. You finish with fiction when you know what happened. You finish with non-fiction when you learn what you want to learn.

Anne wants her readers to know how relationships really work, what makes them thrive and how to find the right mate, et cetera. Professor Glaen spoke in one of their class meetings about Isaac Newton, the man who "refused to guess" and thereby observed and discovered rather than invent theories about how things should work. When you don't have any idea how things work you are teachable. Teachable is when you're willing to unlearn so you can really learn.

Isaac Newton refused theories. He focused on making honest observations. When the proverbial apple hit him on the head, he noticed it fell. He observed the force of gravity at work. Faith has a basis while theories search for basis. It's the difference between trusting and guessing. Hebrews 11:1-Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. God designed gravity and He also designed a way that relationships work. Faith first. Hebrews 11:6 - But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh

to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

Everything is hard before it is easy, and everything is easy once you know how. If you want to see what's really happening in relationships you have got to see them in an instant. The more you look, the more you see. Another key to working on a problem: Assume the answer pre-exists. All you have

to do is observe and work until you find it.

Anne wanted to know the truth about how relationships work and comes to the following turn in the road:

Lie # 1 - No harm in acting married - it's just practice.

TRUTH – You are only married when you're married.

Lie # 2 - God has only one person for you to marry and you will only find happiness if you find that person.

TRUTH – God allows freedom inside the boundary of marrying someone in the Lord and happiness is something you build with the Lord – not demand from your spouse

Lie # 3 - If you follow the right process, you will be guaranteed a good marriage. It isn't a formula that makes the difference.

TRUTH – No process can guarantee a good relationship because there are no future guarantees in relationships. Relationships happen in the present. We don't know the future.

Lie #4 – Sex is something special God wants committed people to enjoy.

TRUTH – When sex is common it isn't special. Sex is something spe-

cial God wants married people to enjoy.

Lie # 5 – Men and women are basically the same.

TRUTH – The differences and not the similarities define women and men.

• Love is a mystery of choices.

- Chemistry in relationships is God's business.
- The basis for our relationships is our business.
- Lust is an appetite which owns its possessor.

Lie # 6 – If you act just the right way and say just the right things, we can get the approval of others and they'll respond the way we want them to.

TRUTH – Speaking the truth with love is the centerpiece of effective relating because it starts with your freedom and ends with theirs. Galatians 5:1 - *Stand fast*

therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage. Freedom is risky because freedom means there is real choice.

Romance is a trap because the best relationships are not about the exciting and unusual, instead they are about connecting together in the common day-to-day world. Since romance is about the unusual and exciting, sex is the highest aim of romance.

As the novelette within a lifeteaching book comes to a close, we see a lot of not so surprising things take shape in Anne's life. Something amusing at the end to ponder: introduced is the idea of the anagram of Professor Glaen's first and last name.

As the college semester progresses, Anne has worked out the original non-fiction title for her book: *The Artful Science of Love: A Field Book for Life Long Relationships* by Anne Hughes.

Glaen is good reading for those among the Lord's people who would like to prepare for life's relationships. You can read it with an open Bible and learn much. men to understand how to raise their children without provoking them to anger but "bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the word." (Ephesians 6:4).







Once he began reading the Bible he began to understand that, "I was a great sinner and Christ is a great Savior." He soon became convicted in some areas of his life; for

example, he broke up with Vanessa because he recognized that their relationship, was sin. She remarked that it was the most unique break-up line she had ever heard. It would be three and a half years later before they got back together and eventually married.

While living in Manhattan Rob attended a church where the gospel message was emphasized and as a result he went to the altar and made the decision to confess his sins, ask forgiveness and accept Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior.

tist Church along with Co-pastor Jack Buckley about three years ago. Through the years he had come to believe that he was a "Reformed Baptist". Reformed Baptist Churches are distinct in that they are both Reformed (adhering to and showing respect for much of the theology defined by John Calvin) as well as Baptists (believing in baptism for believers only, and that by immersion). Historically, the five points of Calvinism have been central tenets of the Reformed faith, which all Reformed Baptist churches agree with by definition.

One Sunday while preaching through the book of Colosians, he felt as if what he was reading "Opened the window of my heart." The more he studied Colossians 1:24-2:5 the more he saw that he was "Utterly struck and extremely challenged by the life and labors of Apostle Paul and became convinced that he portrays an outstanding model for biblical ministry. " He learned that an acquantance, Jeremy Walker who is a pastor of Maidenbower Baptist Church in Crawly, England, had been preaching on the same passages. Like-minded, with the assistance of Jack Buckley, they began the seventeen month long project writing *A Portrait of Paul*.

In a recent artists review, Pastor Rob said that "The aim of the book is to put into the hands of God's people a brief but helpful guide to enable them to understand and identify what a true minister of Christ looks like and how he lives and works ... Christians looking for a church will find a tool with which they can assess the pastors of the flock in light of God's Word, finding men to whom they can commit the care of their souls ... Christians already in a church will be better equipped to pray for their pastor and will further understand what it really means to be shepherded by a man after God's own heart."

Above all else, states Rob, "We hope that the book might help to promote and encourage faithfulness to God in gospel ministry, encouraging and assisting men who seek to follow Paul, just as he also followed Christ. To bad this book, to be released in October, did not exist when the XYZ church was seeking a pastor!

Sometimes the dreams or aspirations that we have made for ourselves prove meaningless in the eyes of our heavenly Father who has established our ways in His Will. We might just find ourselves on an entirely different course altogether. Pastor Rob is a perfect example; his cherished music management career objective happily shattered when he gave it all up to a life serving the Lord. But then again, isn't that exactly what the Lord meant in Math 10:39, He that findeth his life shall lose it: and he that loseth his life for my sake shall find it. Pastor Rob has a new dream now, he hopes to glorify God in all that he does and possibly write some more books with Jack Buckley and others.



RUST, a film of one man's journey through tragedy to faith restored, releases nationwide on DVD in October, 2010. Written and directed by Emmy- and Golden Globenominated actor Corbin Bernsen, the RUST background story is equally good: involving an internationally famous blogger, a rural farming community in southeast Saskatchewan, and a snow-globe-collecting Hollywood star. RUST also is a glimpse into that star's personal, off-screen faith journey—an awareness deepening since the death of his father.

RUST is the story of Jimmy Moore, a former pastor now facing a midlife crisis of faith and "that rust that grows inside all of us." Returning to his rural, childhood home, Jimmy learns that a devastating fire tore through an old farmhouse and killed the family inside. Travis, a friend from Jimmy's youth, has been put in the state psychiatric hospital and blamed for the fire. Gone is everything Jimmy wanted and expected from a return home—everything familiar, simple, secure.

Jimmy's habit is to run from problems, but this is his last stop. His mentor, a pastor, has urged Jimmy to run no more, to stay and fight through the confusion. This time Jimmy stays—but the mystery behind the fire is something most townsfolk want him to forget, to drop.

For Jimmy, and for us, RUST opens a journey of faith to where tragedy ultimately results in triumph. To get there, a weary man of weakened faith must solve a mystery too many people seem eager to cover.

It Starts with a Paper Clip

In the summer of 2005, artist Kyle McDonald set out to trade up for a house. The catch? His starting bid was a single red paperclip. Through a series of 12 Internet exchanges over more than a year, Kyle came into ownership of a snow globe featuring the band KISS. (Between the paper clip and the snow globe, among other items, he owned and traded a jet ski, a recording contract, and a year in Phoenix.)

Enter Corbin Bernsen: actor, writer, director, producer, and one of the world's foremost snow-globe collectors, offering to take that KISS globe for a role in his next movie project. Kyle accepted and turned right around and traded the movie role. The year was July 2006 and the people of Kipling, Saskatchewan, capped the storied trading with a two-story home for Kyle and for the town, a role in Bernsen's next film.

RUST and Kipling: The Beginning of a Wonderful Partnership

Bernsen flew to Kipling and began to make good on his pledge. In 140 auditions, he found a town resident for a part in his film—while Kipling's enterprising mayor pitched the town as just the place for the movie premier. Two problems, though. First, Kipling has no movie theater. Second, Bernsen noticed that the town of 1,100 people and no cinema did have 11 churches.

The plot thickens. Kipling was in a boom of sorts. Farming was good and this was oil patch country. Several leading citizens made a proposal: they'd raise the money for Bernsen's next film if he would write and shoot it in their town. Bernsen said yes and the group raised a quarter million dollars in donations large and small. (One ladies' group pledged their Social Security

"Here I am, a guy somewhat jaded by big movies and TV series," Bernsen told Canada's National Post newspaper, "And here's a town that says, 'We want to raise money for a movie.' I think, 'That's interesting,' and they go raise a quarter million dollars. Go try to raise \$250,000 to make an independent film in L.A." Bernsen's Team Cherokee Productions partnered, then, with Kipling Film Productions, and the result is

Filmmaker Seeks 'Answers' to Darwinism's **Effect on Christian Youth**

PETERSBURG, Ky -- Colin Gunn's school bus tour of America recently arrived at the Creation Museum, shooting footage for the upcoming film, 'Indoctrination: Public Schools and the Decline of Christianity in America'. Gunn interviewed biblical apologist, Ken Ham, about the effects of Darwinism on Christian youth.

As founder of Answers in Genesis and the Creation Museum, Ken Ham shared insights from his book 'Already Gone' -- a book which explains why many young people are leaving the church. Research shows that youth are leaving Christian churches in droves, due largely to the failure of Christians to adequately answer the Darwinian propaganda taught in public schools.

Christians often argue that their children ought to be "salt and light" in the schools, but as Colin Gunn notes, "We know that's not been successful. That sounds good, but it hasn't worked. It's a disaster for the Christian church."

How to Explain to Your Kids - Why You Don't Celebrate Halloween

Halloween has come under close scrutiny by families over the last few years. Some have chosen not to celebrate Halloween because of the connection to pagan and satanic beliefs, others for safety reasons. It can be hard for children to understand parents' decisions, especially when

they see their friends going trick or treating without them or when they are not allowed to attend a party. The history of Halloween blends so many different ideas from so many cultures and religious beliefs that it could take awhile to explain it, especially to younger children. When discussing it with your children, it is important to discuss

your beliefs first. They must have a good foundation or they won't understand the rest of the conversation and the reasons "why". It is important to keep things simple in terms they understand. It is also important to discuss the fact that not everyone believes the same thing.

Show your children Romans 12:2 "And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God." Explain to them that God does not want us to do what everyone else in the world thinks is acceptable, but He wants us to be special and do only the things

that he thinks is acceptable.

You can also explain to your younger children that Halloween is simply too scary, with all the strange costumes and the dangerous items that have been given out to children who are trick or treating. This can also be a good



time to reinforce the dangers of taking things from people they don't know. It can be confusing to children to be told all year that they shouldn't take candy or anything else from strangers, and then one night of the year, it is encouraged.

One of the biggest concerns of Christian parents is the connection to the occult, witchcraft and Satanism. Even though new traditions, such as trick or treating and dressing up in costumes may seem innocent, many people feel it is glorifying things that go against Christian beliefs and should be avoided. By explaining the history behind the traditions, it might help children understand why,

instead of just, "because we said so." Doing a little research from trusted sources could help lead the conversation. Although not all the experts agree on the origins of some of the traditions, most point to similar information.

It is also important to talk about what you can do as a family instead of the traditional Halloween activities. Your family can still have fun, but be more aligned with your beliefs. Many church groups have a "Hallelujah Night" where they get together and play games. This year, our church is having a Har-

vest of Blessing Festival on October 31st. Even if your church doesn't have a similar activity, I'm sure one nearby will have a Festival you can attend. And if there's nothing near your home, you can still do something as a family. You could have a game and pizza night or a family friendly movie night. Your children could even invite other friends.

An important thing to keep in mind is to remain consistent. If you don't celebrate Halloween you need to apply the same standards to other things that fall into the same category. It will avoid confusion.

Thou shalt be perfect

For example, if you don't celebrate Halloween, because of

- MINISTRY TIP

Children learn a great deal from their environment. New sights, sounds, and smells are always grabbing their attention. Young people can improve their environment with the Natural Air Freshener.

To make the Natural Air Freshener you need: Bibles, concordances, oranges, cloves, small bowls and colorful fruit and vegetable stickers.

Ask your students to take small bowls and decorate them on the outside and top inside rim with colorful fruit and vegetable stickers. Give each child an orange to artfully stick cloves into. The fresh smell will immediately fill

the room. Place the oranges into the bowls so each young person has a natural air freshener to bring home.

For a Bible study have your students look up verses about food and fresh smells in their Bibles and concordances. List these on the board.

Ask two students to read Genesis 1:29-30 to the class, then explain that God gave the plants to people and animals for food. Read Proverbs 22:9, which tells us that: "A generous man will himself be blessed, for he shares his food with the poor."

Therefore, we should share our food with the poor. Ask one student to read Ephesians 5:2; explain that we can smell good in a spiritual sense by living a life of love as Jesus did. Close in prayer, asking God to help us be kind, caring and generous people.

RHODE ISLAND DECLARATION

Life, Marriage 🕲 Religious Liberty.

We are Rhode Islanders who are members of different religious traditions. We address this declaration to all citizens, believers and nonbelievers alike, out of our concern over the serious present-day threats to the natural goods of human life, marriage, and religious liberty—each of which is a gift from the Creator for the common good and well-being of all members of society. We invite all men and women of good will to reflect critically on the issues we address here, and to stand with us-and with many men and women of conscience throughout history—to defend these natural goods in the public forum by way of reasoned argument and lawful political action.

Our belief in the wisdom of the Creator and the goodness of the created order is the source of our vision and hopeful efforts for a well-ordered society under the rule of law. We cherish the rule of law and we respect the authority of human legislators. We count it as a special privilege to live in a democratic society where the making of law benefits from the rights of all citizens to participate in the political process. Yet even in a democratic regime, laws can be unjust. Such laws lack the power to bind in conscience because they can claim no authority beyond the sheer force of human will. We stand with Dr. Martin Luther King in his appeal to a higher, universal law of justice: "a just law is a man-made code that squares with the moral law or the law of God. An unjust law is a code that is out of harmony with the moral law."

. . . Human Life

The lives of the unborn, the disabled, and the elderly are increasingly threatened today. While public opinion has moved in a pro-life direction, powerful and determined forces are working to expand abortion, embryo-destructive research, assisted suicide, and euthanasia in open disregard for the intrinsic worth of every individual human life. Government is very often complicit in these threats to human life—at times in the name of the otherwise commendable goal of defending individual rights. But there can be no right deliberately to take innocent human life. Rather, a primary responsibility of government, indeed of us all, is to protect the weak and vulnerable, especially those whose lives are deemed "unwanted" or too burdensome to warrant protection. We pledge to work unceasingly for the equal protection under law of every innocent human being at every stage of development and in every condition. We will refuse to permit ourselves or our institutions to be implicated in the taking of innocent human life and we will support in every possible way those who, in conscience, take the same stand.

Marriage

The institution of marriage, already wounded by promiscuity, infidelity, and divorce is at risk of being redefined and thus subverted. Marriage is the original and most important institution for sustaining the health, education, and welfare of all. Where marriage erodes, social pathologies rise. The impulse to redefine marriage is a symptom, rather than the cause, of the erosion of the marriage culture. But this impulse must be resisted. It reflects a loss of understanding of the meaning of marriage, as embodied in our civil law as well as our religious traditions.

To yield to it would be to forsake any possibility of rebuilding a healthy marriage culture. It would lock into place the pervasive though false and destructive belief that marriage is only about romance and other adult satisfactions, and not, in any intrinsic way, about the unique character and value of bonds and acts whose meaning is shaped by their aptness for the generation and fostering of life. Marriage is not a "social construction." It is an objective reality—the faithful union of man and woman, who by their natural complementarity of body and spirit are uniquely endowed for mutual help, and the upbringing and education of children. It is the duty of the law to recognize, honor, and protect this most basic form of human society.

Religious Liberty

Freedom of religion and the rights of conscience are gravely threatened. The threat is evident in efforts to weaken or eliminate conscience protections for healthcare institutions and professionals, and in antidiscrimination statutes that are used as weapons to force religious institutions, charities, businesses, and service providers either to accept (and even facilitate) activities and relationships they judge immoral, or to go out of business. Attacks on religious liberty are significant threats not only to individuals, but also to the institutions of civil society, including families, charitable organizations, and religious communities. The well-being of such institutions provides an indispensable buffer against excessive governmental power and is essential to the flourishing of every other institution on which society depends, including government itself.

Therefore,

we commit ourselves to the promotion and defense of human life at every stage, of marriage as the faithful union of husband and wife, and of the legitimate rights of conscience. Each of these is inviolable. Each is an essential element of human dignity and the common good of society. We shall work unwaveringly in defense of these principles, through education and active participation in the political process, no matter what pressures are brought upon us and our institutions to abandon or compromise them. We invite all Rhode Islanders to join us in this commitment.
